- This form must be turned in 2 weeks prior to payment due date to receive fee extension. Student is responsible for payment on the last day of term if VA has not made payment.
- This form will be processed after enrollment in classes. Student is responsible for notifying our office of any schedule changes within 7 days. Changes made to your schedule could cause a change to your tuition and fees. Dropping a class could cause you to be in overpayment with VA. Receiving a grade of W or NC will result in a debt to VA.
- You understand the VA will not pay for courses that are not required in your degree program. VA will only pay for study abroad courses if your program requires you to study abroad for completion of your degree. Please see the VA rep before registering for study abroad classes.
- If you are a Chapter 30, 1606, or 1607 recipient you must verify attendance with the VA monthly via WAVE at 1-888-823-2378. VA payment rates can be found on the VA website.
- Post 9/11 students are eligible for a stipend based on your hours of enrollment and percentage of entitlement. If eligible, stipends are paid one month behind and payable at the E-5 with dependents rate. BAH is reduced for less than full time, online programs, and not payable for "1/2 time or less". Full time Undergraduate for fall and spring is 12 hours. Graduate students are full time at 9 hours. Summer terms are rated differently please visit our link at <https://veterans.utk.edu/summer-enrollment/>
- Post 9/11 book stipend academic year maximum is \$1000.00 (August 1 through July 31).

*****Effective July 1, 2017** OUT OF STATE TUITION WAIVER for veterans & dependents**

A veteran or other individual eligible to receive educational benefits administered by the United States Department of Veteran's Affairs, through any provision of federal law, may not be required to pay out-of-state tuition or any out-of-state fee when the veteran or other individual is:

- (1) Enrolled in any public institution of higher education in Tennessee;
- (2) Utilizing such benefits at the enrolling institution; and
- (3) Living in Tennessee, regardless of the individual's formal state of residency.

*Eligibility for VA education benefits is determined by the Department of Veteran Affairs.
